Fiber Optic Technician

A Fiber Optic Technician works full-time and is paid hourly, with standard work hours from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. There are 4 different technician skill sets that COTSWORKS is currently seeking:

1. Test Technician: Responsible for setup and test of our fiber-optic transceiver assemblies. Includes setup changeovers and troubleshooting of Agilent Light wave equipment. Candidates should have a basic understanding of oscilloscopes, power suppliers, and pattern generators. Lab-view experience a plus.
2. Solder Technician: Responsible for the solder assembly and rework of PCBs. Will be required to regularly use microscopes and assembly fixtures to attach headers and optics to PCB assemblies, as well as perform incoming inspection. Experience with SMT components, such as 0402 and 0201 EIA size codes required. Knowledge of IPC-A-610 and J-STD-001 a plus.
3. Assembly Technician: Responsible for the assembly and disassembly of fiber-optic transceivers. Good hand-eye coordination and use of basic hand tools a must, IPCA-610 a plus, as well as general assembly experience.
4. Fiber Cable Technician: Responsible for the assembly of fiber-optic cables and cable assemblies. Duties include fiber termination, (stripping, crimping, epoxying, curing) and final polishing and inspection. Fiber-optic experience a plus, but copper cable harness assembly experience also acceptable.
